

Explore the attractions...

The Mornington Peninsula has a diverse range of attractions. Take a drive to Pearcedale and then head down the Western Port side of the Peninsula for lunch and other delights.



10:00 am – Moonlit Sanctuary and Wildlife Conservation Park – Visit the bush food garden and try some native fare. Enjoy a close encounter with kangaroos, wombats and other Australian animals. Have your photo taken with a koala!

12 noon – travel down the Westernport side of the Peninsula and stop in either:

Balnarring: **Ciao Bella Pizzeria and Wine Bar – 2998 Frankston Flinders Road, Balnarring** – open from 12 noon Wed to Sunday

Or

Somers General Store – 2 The Boulevard, Somers open from 8am – 4:30pm everyday.



2:00pm – Cape Schanck Lighthouse – Tour the lighthouse that still flashes its beacon across the wild waters of Bass Strait guiding mariners as it has done for more than 100 years. Explore historic buildings and the lighthouse museum.



4:00pm Peninsula Hot Springs – Natural hot mineral springs flow into public pools and private baths at the hot springs and spa facility. More than 20 different bathing experiences including a cave pool, reflexology walk and Turkish steam bath. The kids are permitted and will love it all.
