

## Mazes and Gardens...

See how this unique part of the world has been inspiring artists for more than a century by visiting the magnificent landscapes, gardens and orchards, then wind down your day by devouring the mouth-watering delights that await you at one of the many cellar doors, restaurants and cafes.



**10:00 am – Enchanted Maze Garden** – Gardens are combined with over 1000 works of sculpture by current and former artists in residence. The sculpture park is set in 5 acres of native bushland with giant tree sculptures that will amaze you. Enliven the sense in a wonderland of mazes topiary, sculptural creations and annual Maize Maze carved into a corn field. Challenge yourself with a brain tear and games and explore a world of fantasy gardens. There is so much here for the kids, tube sliding, a 3-D Maze and of course the ever popular lolly shop. There is a café on site and restaurant or you could take a picnic..you could be here all day but allow yourself at least a couple of hours.



**12 noon** – If you are not eating a picnic lunch and want to try something else try **T'Gallant Winery** just down the road as it has outdoor tables and the kids can run around. There are sometimes horses in the adjacent field which always intrigue the kids and they do great pizza's.



**1:30pm – Sunny Ridge Strawberry Farm** – Australia's largest producer of ripe, juicy strawberries. Pick your own (Nov-Apr) or visit the showroom and indulge in the ultimate strawberry treats. Devonshire tea is yum.

**3:00pm Seawinds** – Seawinds is a 34 hectare property managed by Parks Victoria with magnificent views of Port Phillip Bay, the Mornington and Bellarine Peninsulas. There are many short walks to take at Seawinds. An 800 metre walk around the gardens takes in most of the main features. There is a track that leads from the car park west to "Bay Lookout" which faces west across McCrae, Rosebud, Rye and Sorrento to the heads of Port Phillip Bay and Queenscliff on the Bellarine Peninsula . By following the track north it will take you to the "Northern Lookout" where you can see Arthurs Seat is in the foreground and on a clear day, Mount Dandenong , the Great Dividing Range and the skyline of Melbourne .
